

BHS TRUST FUND - Cookies Policy

We ask that you read this cookie policy carefully as it contains important information on our use of cookies or similar technologies on our website. This policy should be read together with our [privacy policy](#) which sets out how and why we collect, store, use and share personal information generally, as well as your rights in relation to your personal information and details of how to contact us and supervisory authorities in the event you have a complaint.

Information about our use of cookies

Websites generally use cookies to distinguish a user from other users of the website. This helps to provide users with a good experience when they browse websites and also allow to improve a site.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that are stored on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

For example, we may monitor how many times you visit the website. This information helps to build a profile of users. Some of this data will be aggregated or statistical, which means that we will not be able to identify you individually.

You can set your browser not to accept cookies and www.aboutcookies.org or www.allaboutcookies.org tell you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, some of the website features may not function as a result.

For further information on cookies generally visit those sites.

We do not use any of the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of some websites and are essential for users to be able to navigate various websites and use their features.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** They would allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps to improve the way a website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise users when they return to a website. This allows a website to remember the choices a user makes and provide enhanced, more personal features.
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record users' visit to a website, the pages a user has visited and the links a user has followed. However, we do not use this information to make our website more relevant to your interests. We also do not use external advertising within our website.

The only cookies that you will come across when visiting our website are the following:

- **Social media cookies.** These cookies are used when you share information using your social media accounts.

Consent

In the event that we will in the future start using cookies we will ask for your permission (consent) to place cookies or other similar technologies on your device, except where these are essential for us to provide you with a service that you have requested.

Third-party cookies

Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

Social media cookies are third party cookies placed on our site. For example, when you click a button or link and visit our profile on their sites. These actions take you away from our main site and onto theirs or opens the site in a new browser tab.

How to turn off cookies

You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of a website.
